2	Eligibility	<p>All the regular Technicians(C&W) of Mechanical(C&W) Department in Pay Level-2, Level-4, Level-5 & Level-6 are eligible for JE(C&W) against 25% IAQ subject to the following conditions:</p> <p>a. Length of service: Should have working in the Mechanical department and have completed 03 years of continuous Railway service in skilled grade as on the date of notification. However, candidates who have joined in KUR division on transfer on request basis, their length of service for determining the eligibility for the above post will be counted in terms of RBE. No. 34/2006 & RBE No. 99/2006.</p> <p>b. Educational Qualification:</p> <p>(i) Degree or Diploma in Electrical/ Mechanical Engineering branch including their sub stream branches, if any (RBE No.81/2025)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>(ii) Should have the qualification of ITI/Act apprenticeship in the relevant trade</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>(iii) Should have the qualification of 10+2 Science [RBE No.145/2003]</p> <p>c. Age: The upper age limit should not be more than 47 years as on date of notification.</p> <p>In terms of RBE No.117/2006, the cut-off date for determining the eligibility of staff should be the date of issue of notification. As such the volunteering employees should stand fulfil the eligibility conditions as on the date of issue of notification.</p>			
3	Medical Standard	Should be fit in B1 (Bee-One) medical classification.			
4	Syllabus	The syllabus for written test is enclosed at Annexure-B .			
5	Publication of Eligible/Ineligible List	The eligible staff who satisfy the prescribed condition of eligibility may apply in the format (Annexure-A) attached with this notification. After scrutiny of option applications, eligible and ineligible list of applicants will be published. Only eligible candidates will be called for to appear in the CBT/TBT mode.			
6	Pre-selection coaching for SC/ST candidates	In terms of Railway Board Circular, No B3-E(SCT)42/1 dated 14.04.1983, pre promotional training will not be imparted to the eligible SC/ST candidates as there is no reserved vacancy and SC/ST candidates have to appear the Selections/LDCEs against un-reserved vacancies.			


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7	Mode of selection	<p>The eligible staff who satisfy the above prescribed conditions of eligibility will be called for selection which will comprise of written examination on CBT/TBT Mode followed by scrutiny of Service Record, last three years' APARs. Those securing minimum 60% marks in written test will be considered for next stage (Scrutiny of SR & APARs) and those securing 60% or more in aggregate and free from SPE/Vigilance/D&AR cases will qualify for being included in the panel as per vacancy. The panel will be declared purely in order of merit on aggregate marks only.</p> <p>Written Examination: The question of the written examination will be 100% objective multiple choice type both in Hindi & English.</p> <p>The written examination will be a Computer Based Test (CBT)/Tablet Based Test (TBT) where there will be no physical question paper. All questions will appear in the Computer/Tablet and the candidate will have to mark their responses/answers to the questions on Computer/Tablet.</p> <p>There will be 110 questions of objective multiple-choice type with four answer options. Out of 110 questions, 10 questions (optional) will be from "Rajbhasha" and the candidates have to answer a maximum of 100 questions. If any candidate answered more than 100 questions, then the first 100 attempted questions will count for evaluation.</p> <p>There shall be negative marking for wrong/incorrect answers. One third (1/3) of the marks allotted to for each question will be deducted for every wrong answer.</p> <p>In terms of RBE.No.91/2022, after completion of main written examination, the Answer key will be published in RRC/BBS official website [https://rrcbbs.org.in].</p> <p>The answer/response sheets will be evaluated in terms of provisions contained in RBE No.59/2022 & RBE No.122/2023 through computerized mode.</p> <p>Both physical and biometric attendance will be marked at the examination venue.</p> <p>The candidates who will qualify the written test should have passed the prescribed medical standard for the notified post.</p> <p>The final panel will be drawn for notified vacancies in order of merit from those secure a minimum 60% marks in the professional ability (i.e. written test) and 60% marks in the aggregate in "Record of Service", last three years APARs. However, those who secure minimum 60% marks in the written test, their Service Records & APARs will be scrutinized. The promotion of the empaneled candidates are subject to passing of requisite medical standard, SPE/Vigilance/D&AR clearance and promotional course training as required as per extant rules. Since this is a safety category of post, there will be no relaxation in marks for SC/ST candidates. There will be no provision of Supplementary examination.</p>
8	Duration of the written test	The duration of written test will be 02:00 Hrs.(120 Minutes).
9	Objection Tracker	The provisional answer key will be uploaded in the RRC/BBS' official website [https://rrcbbs.org.in] on completion of the written test. The Examinees may submit their representations, if any, in the provided link in respect to the provisional answer key within 03 days from the date of written test. No further correspondence about any wrong answer/question will be entertained after the above stipulated period.



10	Issue of Admit Card	RRC/ECOR will issue e-admit card online (through the website https://rrcbbs.org.in) to eligible and willing employees for appearing in the CBT/TBT. Examination venue and time of reporting for written examination will be there in the admit card. As no physical communication will be made after issue of this vacancy notice, it will be the responsibility of the concerned employees to regularly visit https://rrcbbs.org.in website for an update and to download the e-admit cards when made available.
11	Procedure of CBT/TBT	A mock test will be conducted at the exam venue before starting of main CBT/TBT, explaining as to how the question will be appearing and how to mark the responses/ answers in the actual examination. Both physical and biometric attendance marking will be done at the examination venue.
12	Option scrutinization process	Willing & eligible employees who fulfill the above eligibility criteria will submit their applications in the prescribed Performa (Annexure-A) to their controlling supervisors on or before 05.06.2026 (Closing date) who will forward the applications to the Branch Officer of the concerned Department on or before 09.06.2026 . After initial scrutiny, the concerned Branch Officer will forward the applications in a bunch of eligible staff only who fulfill the above eligibility conditions, to the Personnel Department of this Division under a covering letter with consolidated statements on or before 16.06.2026 positively.
13	Schedule	(A) (i) Last date to submit the application: 05.06.2026 (ii) Last date of submission of all the applications to Personnel Department by Branch officer (in a single bunch) :16.06.2026 (B) Other tentative dates : (i) Publication of Eligibility list:30.06.2026 (ii) Date of TBT/CBT test: 30.07.2026
14	General Conditions	The eligible staff on leave/sick/training/deputation should also be intimated. All Subordinate In-charges should submit a certificate in this regard that all the staff under their control have been intimated. This notification should be given wide publicity amongst the staff concerned working under their control. Administration reserves all rights to cancel or amend the notification partly or wholly at any time without any prior notice or assigning any reason thereof.
15	Other conditions	Any other provisions of IREM or circular issued by Railway Board regarding terms and conditions of above selection and other conditions applicable, if any, inadvertently omitted in this notification should be treated as valid and operative.
